

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in and agrees to purchase electric energy from the Gibson Electric Membership Corporation (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which will constitute the Applicant's initial membership fee.
2. The Applicant will purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below, and will pay, therefore, monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the by-laws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may be limited in the amount of power that it can furnish due to limitations made by the wholesale power supplier, the Tennessee Valley Authority. The Applicant further agrees that the Cooperative on some occasions may be unable to furnish electric power due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances.
3. The Applicant agrees to furnish all necessary right-of-way, for electric or communication lines together with permission to cut or trim all trees when necessary, also free access to the premises of the consumer by the Cooperative for the purpose of inspecting, reading, repairing or removing said lines and equipment.
4. Applicant agrees that in the event of nonpayment of any amounts due the Cooperative, applicant will pay all reasonable attorney and collector's fees for collection of same, by suit or otherwise.
5. The Applicant will cause premises or new wiring to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by all applicable Cooperative, local, State, and National Electric Safety Codes.
6. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the Tennessee Electric Cooperative Act of 1988, by the provisions for the certificate of incorporation and by-laws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as have or may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative. Copies of those may be seen during business hours at the office of the Cooperative in Trenton, Tennessee.
7. The Applicant, by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative, and the Contract for electric service shall continue in force from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant, and thereafter until cancelled by either party.
8. If the application is for temporary service, the undersigned agrees that the responsibility for any damages suffered through the use of electric energy or equipment during this period or prior to any final inspection is applicant and that the Cooperative or its employees shall in no way be liable for the above causes. It is also agreed that his property shall be available for electrical inspection at any reasonable hour until such time that final approval of wiring is given by the authorized electrical inspector of the State of Tennessee. It is also agreed that connection will continue on a temporary basis for a maximum of 12 months and the Cooperative will have the right to discontinue the service unless special permission is granted by the Cooperative for any extension of time.
9. The Cooperative retains ownership of all electric facilities installed by them. If any facilities are unused for 6 or more months, the cooperative may remove the unused facilities without further notification.
